

Jericho is actually a suburb of Oxford U.K. where the Oxford University Press factory is and the story was predominantly set amongst the workers there before during and after the 1914–18 War.

Oxford was also where many injured soldiers both British and Belgian in particular were hospitalised and led to a romance when the main character offers to read to one with a severe eye injury, but it did not continue after the War as she had hopes of winning a scholarship and he, an architect, to help rebuilding his home town in Belgium.
